We do this for two primary reasons:

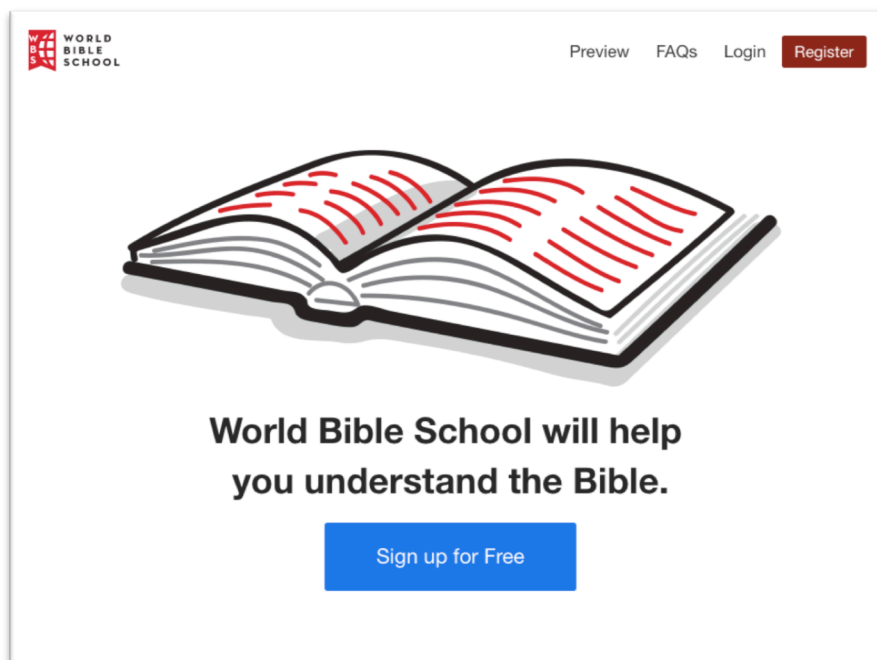


PERSONAL PREPARATION: DiscipleTrips isn't just a catchy name. It describes who we are and what we do. The word "disciple" means student. We want to help you grow as a disciple and believe pre-trip, biblical preparation is important. For many, these lessons will be a good review of the things you've learned as a disciple. We are going on a mission trip to "make disciples" (Matt 28:19) and encourage the local disciples we meet. Taking the time to study and review vital teachings from God's Word will help us fulfill our purpose.

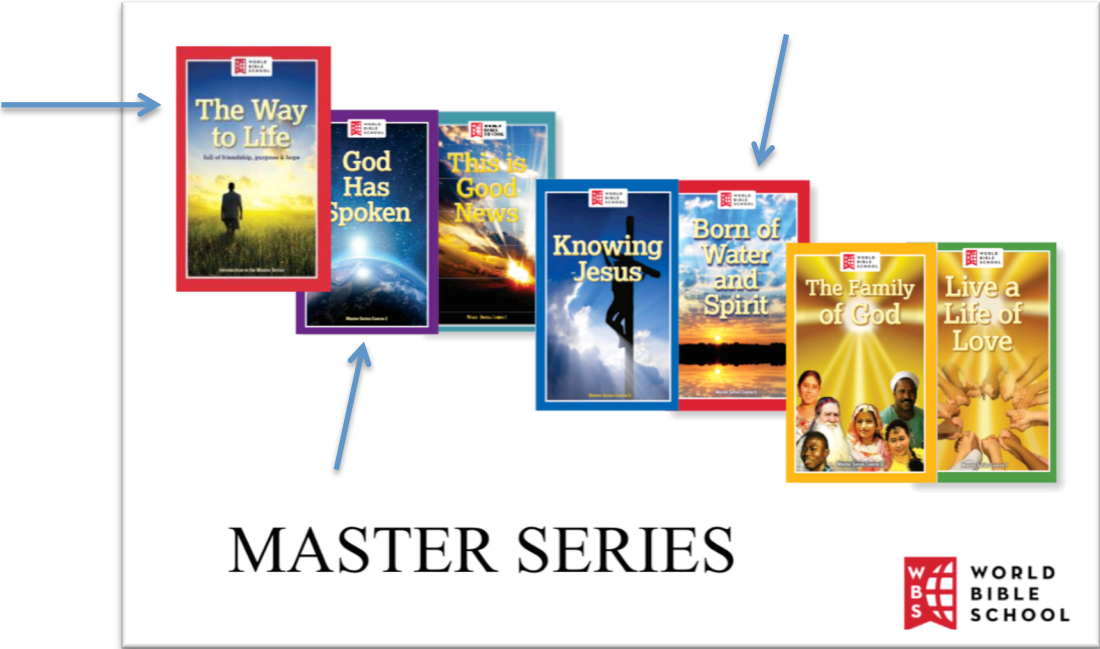
EVANGELISTIC RESOURCE: As you become familiar with WBS Online, you will quickly realize what an amazing tool it is for world evangelism. After you've completed the prescribed course, we want you to become a World Bible School teacher and begin to use this resource to reach the world from your home. It's cool because you'll be doing mission work before your mission trip begins! This tool also provides you the opportunity to sign-up some of the people you meet on your mission trip. Imagine being able to continue "making disciples" long after the trip is over.

Getting Started: DiscipleTrips has our own private link into World Bible School. This allows us to connect you with a DiscipleTrip mentor (teacher) who understands why you're using WBS and knows which courses to assign.

You will need an email address to register. You'll be asked to create a password and answer a few basic questions. Once you're finished registering, you should be able to get started on your first lesson entitled, "The Way." Within a few days, you'll hear back from a DiscipleTrip mentor who will encourage you through these courses.



The Master Series includes 7 modules. After you complete "The Way to Life" (Intro lesson), you only need to complete 2 of the remaining series: "God Has Spoken" (8 lessons) and "Born of Water and the Spirit" (9 lessons). Once you are finished, you are welcome to work on the other courses if you'd like. However, we definitely want you to move to the final stage of this process and become a World Bible School teacher.

Becoming a WBS Teacher:

Once you've completed your prescribed course with DiscipleTrips, your mentor will ask for your email address. They will make contact with WBS and you will receive an email from World Bible School with instructions to complete a short application. Within a few days, you'll be approved and be able to select any two students you choose from the Student Board.
